UPDATE to Incident Reported: Shots Fired

Date/Time of Incident: 10/17/23 12:55am

Location: In the Groves, adjacent to El Camino Real

The Department of Public Safety does not believe that the incident presents an ongoing threat to the community. The victim's injury was not life-threatening. The Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office is leading the investigation of this incident.

Type of Incident Reported: Shots Fired

Date/Time of Incident: 10/17/23 12:55am

Location: In the Groves, adjacent to El Camino Real

Additional Details: At 10/17/23, at 12:55 am, an individual residing in a tent in the grove area, adjacent El Camino Real between Palm Drive and Galvez Street (near Medical Foundation Way,) reported being shot by an unknown assailant while she was in the tent. Victim sustained an injury to an extremity. She was transported to the hospital for further treatment. No suspect description at this time.
